

## Splendour in the Grass 2023 Vehicle Pass - Conditions of Entry

*Please be aware that upon purchase of your Vehicle Pass (hereafter also referred to as "Pass") you accept the terms and conditions listed below:*

1. It is a condition of Splendour in the Grass 2023 ("the Event") that you must pre-purchase a Pass for any vehicle you intend to bring into the Campgrounds precinct at North Byron Parklands (the "Venue Campgrounds"). This includes private vehicles, private RV, Campervan (4 Berth or Larger than 6 Metres), or any vehicle towing a Caravan, Trailer, Camper Trailer or any other towed device, any hire vehicles, and utilities. Two-wheeled motorbikes (without a sidecar) do not require a Pass, although they are subject to all other conditions and/or restrictions relating to vehicle movements.
2. All vehicles entering the Venue Campgrounds must have the appropriate pre-purchased Pass from [www.moshtix.com.au](http://www.moshtix.com.au) valid for entry only on the date/s, time/s and entry gate/s specified on the Pass. Passes must be displayed as per the instruction printed on the Pass. You MUST arrive on the day, time and entry gate assigned on your Pass or your vehicle will be denied entry to the Venue.
3. Vehicles not displaying a valid Pass WILL NOT be allowed to enter the Venue Campgrounds.
4. Ensure that the type of Pass and the details printed on it are correct.
5. One Pass is required per vehicle. Each vehicle occupant does not require a Pass and only **ONE** Pass is required for the duration that the vehicle is parked in the Venue Campgrounds. Passes are not re-usable on more than one vehicle and must not be altered. Such actions will render the Pass null and void and may result in you being refused admission to the Event and Venue Campgrounds.
6. Passes are valid until 5pm Monday 24 July 2023 by which time all ticketholders and private vehicles must depart the Venue Campgrounds.
7. Your Pass must be printed and placed on the dashboard of your vehicle, as per the instruction printed on the Pass.
8. The Pass should be positioned so that it is clearly visible from the exterior of the vehicle but does not obstruct the driver's vision.
9. The Pass needs to be placed in position well before arriving at the Venue as it will need to be seen by police and traffic controllers as you approach the Venue Campgrounds and also assists our staff in knowing where to direct your vehicle once inside the Venue Campgrounds.
10. Treat your Pass like cash, as Passes are sold on a strict no refund, no exchange, and no replacement basis. Passes are refunded under the relevant consumer laws that protect the organiser, the venue and ticket purchaser. A change in your personal plans or circumstances does not warrant a refund.
11. Passes contain a barcode that will be scanned upon arrival. Do not damage or tamper with this barcode or your entry may be delayed or denied.
12. Your Pass is only applicable for private use vehicles. It is not valid for taxis, trucks, buses or commercial minibuses.
13. Once your vehicle is parked in the Campgrounds precinct, it is not permitted to be moved again until you depart the Event. Failure to adhere to this may result in your Event & Camping wristband being removed by staff as you exit.
14. The Pass does not allow your vehicle to park in the Event or Venue Day Car Park.
15. The Pass does not include entry to the Event or entitlement to camping. Each occupant of a vehicle entering the Venue Campgrounds must also hold a valid 2023 Event Ticket and Camping Ticket.
16. Passes may not, without the prior written consent of Splendour in the Grass Pty Ltd, be resold at a premium or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services. If you sell or use your Pass in breach of this condition, you will be refused admission.
17. To the fullest extent allowable under law, you agree to indemnify and hold harmless Splendour in the Grass Pty Ltd, its employees, contractors and sub-contractors from any costs, damage, liability, injury or death howsoever caused related to your use of the Pass.
18. Passes are non-exchangeable and non-refundable. Passes are not eligible for resale or reissue.
19. Please see [www.splendourinthegrass.com](http://www.splendourinthegrass.com) for a full list of banned items which cannot be taken into the Event or the Venue Campgrounds.

20. Banned items will be confiscated and may be held by Splendour in the Grass Pty Ltd for the duration of the Event. Any confiscated items are left entirely at your own risk and Splendour in the Grass Pty Ltd is not liable for any loss or damage to any confiscated items.
21. Guests and/or visitors of camping ticketholders are not permitted in the Venue Campgrounds.
22. For entry into and whilst at the Venue Campgrounds, minors and their parent and/or responsible adult guardian must abide by the Event Youth Policy as detailed at [www.splendourinthegrass.com](http://www.splendourinthegrass.com).
