Splendour in the Grass 2023 Day Parking Pass - Conditions of Entry

Please be aware that upon purchase of a Day Parking Pass (hereafter also referred to as "Pass") you accept the terms and conditions listed below:

- It is a condition of Splendour in the Grass 2023 ("the Event") that you must pre-purchase a Day Parking Pass to gain access to the Day Car Park at North Byron Parklands (the "Venue Day Car Park") in a private vehicle. This includes rental vehicles. Two-wheeled motorbikes (without a sidecar) do not require a Pass, although they are subject to all other conditions and/or restrictions relating to vehicle movements.
- 2. Passes are required per day for entry to the Venue Day Car Park. Separate Passes will be required for entry on either Friday 21, Saturday 22 and/or Sunday 23 July 2023. No entry to the Venue Day Car Park will be granted outside of these dates.
- 3. The Venue Day Car Park hours of operation are 10am-2am Friday 21, Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 July 2023.
- 4. All vehicles entering the Venue Day Car Park must have the appropriate valid pre-purchased Pass from www.moshtix.com.au valid for entry only on the date/s specified on the Pass. Passes must be displayed as per the instruction printed on the pass. You must arrive on the day and at the entry gate assigned on your Pass or your vehicle will be denied entry to the Venue Day Car Park.
- 5. Vehicles not displaying a valid Pass WILL NOT be allowed entry to the Venue Day Car Park.
- 6. Vehicles cannot be left in the Venue Day Car Park overnight and sleeping in vehicles in the Venue Day Car Park is not allowed. If you plan to drink alcohol, please organise a designated driver, catch a bus or make alternate travel arrangements.
- 7. Ensure that you have the correct type of Pass.
- 8. Passes apply to one vehicle only. Passes are not re-usable on more than one vehicle, on more than one day and must not be altered. Such actions will render the Pass null and void and may result in you being refused admission to the Venue Day Car Park and the Event.
- 9. A Pass is valid during the Venue Day Car Park hours of operation for the day specified on the Pass. At the end of each day specified on the Pass, all private vehicles must depart the Venue Day Car Park.
- 10. Treat your Pass like cash, as Passes are sold on a strict no refund, no exchange, and no replacement basis. Passes are refunded under the relevant consumer laws that protect the organiser, the venue and ticket purchaser. A change in your personal plans or circumstances does not warrant a refund.
- 11. Do not damage or tamper with the Pass or your entry may be delayed or denied.
- 12. Your Pass must be printed and placed on the dashboard of your vehicle, as per the instruction printed on the Pass.
- 13. The Pass should be positioned so that it is clearly visible from the exterior of the vehicle but does not obstruct the driver's vision.
- 14. The Pass needs to be in position well before arriving at the Venue Day Car Park as it will need to be seen by police and traffic controllers as you approach North Byron Parklands and also assists our staff in knowing where to direct your vehicle once inside the Venue Day Car Park.
- 15. Passes contain a barcode that will be scanned upon arrival. Do not damage or tamper with this barcode or your entry may be delayed or denied.
- 16. Your Pass is only applicable for private use vehicles. It is not valid for taxis, trucks, buses or commercial minibuses.
- 17. Your Pass does not include entry to the Event or entitlement to camping. Each occupant of a vehicle entering the Venue Day Car Park must also hold a valid 2023 Event Ticket.
- 18. The Pass does not allow your vehicle to park in the Event and Venue Campgrounds precinct.

- 19. Passes may not, without the prior written consent of Splendour in the Grass Pty Ltd, be resold at a premium or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes (including competitions and trade promotions) or to enhance the demand for other goods or services. If you sell or use your Pass in breach of this condition, you will be refused admission.
- 20. To the fullest extent allowable under law, you agree to indemnify and hold harmless Splendour in the Grass Pty Ltd, its employees, contractors and sub-contractors from any costs, damage, liability, injury or death howsoever caused related to your use of the Pass.
- 21. Passes are non-exchangeable and non-refundable. Passes are not eligible for resale or reissue.

- 23. For entry into and whilst at the Venue Day Car Park, minors and their parent and/or responsible adult guardian must abide by the Event Youth Policy as detailed at <u>www.splendourinthegrass.com</u>.
